### Place:

The X Energy Week will be held at Best Western Premier Marina Las Condes, Alonso de Córdova 5727, 7560927 Santiago, Las Condes, Región Metropolitana.

### Registration and Accreditation:

Attendees must be pre-registered, which can be done online at the following link:

<https://semanadelaenergia.olade.org/>. Accreditation at the event venue will begin on Tuesday, September 30th from 8:00 am and will be available every day of the exhibition. All attendees must go through the accreditation process.

### Travel-Visa:

Delegations accredited from OLADE Member Countries will have their travel details in advance. MERCOSUR member countries can travel with their respective ID, while other countries must have a valid passport (at least six months after the departure date) and have completed the visa process if necessary (we recommend visiting the following link to check the entry requirements to the country: <https://www.consulado.gob.cl/informacion-sobre-visas-para-ingresar-a-chile>

### Transport:

Arturo Merino Benítez International Airport is the busiest and most connected airport in Chile. It is located in the Pudahuel commune in the city of Santiago, 26, 5 km from the event location.

**Taxis:** The airport can be accessed through any taxi company; taxis can be taken on the street or called by phone. The price from the airport to the Best Western Premier Marina Las Condes is approximately US\$35. This journey takes no more than X minutes during peak hours.

**Private transport:** Private transport service is available in the arrivals area of the terminal, but it is most convenient to book them before arriving, and through these you can access any point in the city.

**Tourist companies:** You can book a personalized transfer, where they will wait for you at the disembarkation gate of your flight with your name on a sign to take you to your destination.

**Airport – hotel – airport:** The accredited delegations of OLADE Member Countries will have a transport that will receive them at the airport and take them to their hotel.

### Currency:

The peso has been the legal tender of the Republic of Chile since 1975. The bills in circulation are \$1,000, \$2,000, \$5,000, \$10,000, and \$20,000.

The usual operating hours of the currency exchange establishments are Monday to Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and on Saturdays until noon.

### General Information:

**Time:** Continental Chile operates on UTC-4 (standard time) and UTC-3 (daylight saving time, from September to April).

**Electricity:** The standard voltage is 220V with a frequency of 50Hz. Plug types used are C and L.

Visitors are advised to bring an adapter or transformer to avoid any inconvenience.

**Language:** Spanish is the official language of Chile.

**Communication:** The international dialing code for Chile is +56 9.

**Emergency Numbers:** Ambulance (SAMU): 131, Fire Department: 132, Police (Carabineros): 133.

### Climate:

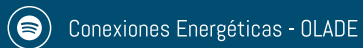
Santiago de Chile during the months of September and October experiences a transition from winter to spring, characteristic of its Mediterranean temperate climate.

In September, temperatures begin to gradually rise, with highs ranging from 18°C to 22°C and lows oscillating between 6°C and 10°C. By October, the weather becomes warmer and more pleasant, with maximum temperatures reaching 20°C to 25°C and lows between 8°C and 12°C.

Precipitation during these months is scarce, as September marks the end of the winter rainy season. In September, some occasional showers may still

occur, with an average of 20 mm of rain. By October, rains are almost non-existent, averaging 10 mm, and the days are mostly sunny and clear.

Relative humidity in the environment during these months is moderate, averaging 60-70%. September may present colder and somewhat foggy mornings, especially in low-lying areas, while in October the weather becomes more stable and spring-like, with longer and more pleasant days.
